- **November Minutes Approval**
 - Jon Girand moved to approve the November minutes
 - Dan Roussin seconded the motion
 - Unanimous approval
- **City Updates - Derek Fern**
 - Engineering team went before Council (Monday, 12/11) to discuss bond projects
 - Ralston Road phase 2
 - 90% complete
 - Data on costs, risks, and challenges are available
 - W. 72nd
 - Making progress on railroad access points
 - Utility bond projects
 - \$50M water bond
 - \$50M sewer bond
 - 80% will be spent by 2024
 - City has had APWA accreditation renewed (3-year accreditation)
 - Third time in a row
 - Ward and 64th subarea plan
 - Subarea plan website has information on newly completed projects
 - CED team has started on new improvement projects
 - Trail counter program
 - Kellee Van Bruggen has obtained new counts of trail users from May 3-Nov. 30
 - Data collected from three permanent counters
 - She is setting up two new counters this week
 - Areas of data collection include:
 - Little Dry Creek Trail
 - Ralston Creek Trail (east)
 - Between Pierce Street and Wadsworth Boulevard
 - Ralston Creek Trail (west)
 - Eldridge and Indiana
 - Strava Metro app can be used to track where trail users are traveling
 - Lime has been deploying scooters in Arvada
 - New E-bike will collect data on trail conditions and take photos of the trail

 - Deliverable 1: State of existing system
 - Includes traffic information
 - All traffic counts may not be from 2023
 - Due to Arvada on Dec. 15th
 - Will be distributed to TAC by Jan. 4th

 - TAC will provide comments on TSP via City staff
 - Technical advisory committee met with consultant and TAC members
 - Consultant has not reviewed existing conditions with technical advisory committee
 - Committee will invite Mazedur and consultant to Jan. 28th meeting
