### 2. Transportation System Plan (Mike Griffith, Mazedur Hossain)

- a. Discussed gaps in Arvada transportation system
  - i. Discussed additions:
    - 1. Increase right-of-way area
    - 2. Reduce traffic signals where possible
- b. Goals:
  - i. Align capacity with usage and demands for all modes of travel
  - ii. Connectivity for all modes of travel with capacity to address future demand
  - iii. Plan for a C level of service for all transportation modes
  - iv. Enhance tools to keep things moving through intersections
  - v. Prioritize sidewalk connectivity in all walkable areas
  - vi. Make non-vehicle travel easier
  - vii. Establish reliable transit in Arvada
  - viii. Create transportation funding vehicle
  - ix. Collaborate to invest in implementable solutions
  - x. Improve safety
  - xi. Improve service to disadvantaged/disabled communities
