**1. Call to Order**

**2. Adopt Minutes**

- a. Jon moved to adopt the January 2026 meeting minutes. Jim Arndt seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

**3. Public Comment**

- a. Lynn Clemmons commented on a warehouse development at ~60th and McIntyre and the potential increase in traffic.
- b. The committee discussed how growth is considered in the Transportation System Plan (TSP).
  - i. Kellee van Bruggen said the model used for the TSP does not consider growth related to developments outside of historical growth trajectories.

**4. City Staff Updates**

a. Transportation planning

- i. Mountain Rail
  - 1. CDOT/Arvada kickoff meeting in March
    - a. Station Study beginning soon
- ii. RTD Subregional Service Council
  - 1. Tentative agenda includes:
    - a. Partnership Call for projects
    - b. Comprehensive Operations Analysis Introduction
    - c. Bust Stop Infrastructure Accessibility Update
- iii. Comprehensive Safety Action Plan
  - 1. Draft available for review in March
    - a. Will be finalized in May
  - 2. Serves in addition to TSP work completed
  - 3. Developed High Injury Network (corridors and intersections)
    - a. Proposes countermeasures that can be incorporated into project design
  - 4. Will still use the TSP as a guide for project prioritization

b. Parking

- i. Walker Parking Consultants
  - 1. Working on SOW for paid parking models
- ii. In-house operations
  - 1. Parking ambassadors have started 2/17

c. Bike/Ped work

- i. Bike lane improvements
  - 1. 17 segments have been resurfaced
    - a. Updating lanes to meet current standards

- b. Work starts in April
- ii. DRCOG Set-aside Funding
  - 1. Multi-Station G Line Mobility Hub study approved
    - a. Study will look at four G-line stations in Arvada and Wheat Ridge
    - b. Goal is to enhance connectivity and ridership experience
    - c. Study timeframe is 1 year
    - d. Study is \$150,000

d. Traffic

- i. 3 signal corridor re-timings completed
  - 1. 64th Ave performed by DRCOG
  - 2. Indiana St
  - 3. 86th Pkwy
- ii. 3 signal corridor re-timings scheduled
  - 1. 80th Ave (May 2026)
  - 2. 72nd Ave (Oct./Nov. 2026)
  - 3. 58th/Ralston performed by DRCOG (January 2027)
- iii. 80th Ave HSIP signal design project to be bid in Q1/Q2
  - 1. 80th and Yarrow
  - 2. HSIP Grant #4 submitted to CDOT on 2/19
- e. Roadway and Bridge
  - i. Annual pavement program-Preparing to pave 75 lane miles

**5. Review recommendation letter for council**

- a. TAC members discussed a letter to City Council, which recommends extending 72 bus route to better serve west Arvada
- b. Jon Girand moved to send the letter to the City Council. Jadwiga Brown seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

**6. Project 1 - Additional Transit Coverage** - Kellee will discuss the Transit On-Demand plan from Via Mobility and assist with the discussion on how the committee wishes to proceed with possible recommendations to Council

- a. Previous high-level analysis was conducted for transit-on-demand services
- b. Previous study included large and small zones
- c. Updates:
  - i. Continued TAC advocacy
  - ii. On-Demand Ridership Zones reflected in the TSP
  - iii. Evaluating partnership models (e.g. RTD Ridership Programs)
- d. TAC members discussed funding vehicles for transit-on-demand options.
- e. Members encouraged feeding transit locations with transit-on-demand.
- f. Nicholas Frazee mentioned CU Boulder subsidization of Uber/Lyft rides for students and possible parallel with Arvada transit needs.
- g. Members discussed attending a City Council meeting or sending a letter.
