1. **Call to Order**
2. **Adopt Minutes:** Jon Girand moved to approve the minutes. Terri Binder seconded the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.
3. **Public Comment:**
 - a. Lynn Clemmons discussed warehouse development at 63rd and McIntyre. A traffic engineer is applying a land use analysis.
4. **City Staff Updates:**
 - a. Vision Zero Resolution:
 - i. Key components: goal with timeframe. 5% decrease in fatalities and serious injuries every year. Measurable metric moving forward.
 - ii. Will present to Council on May 19th
 - iii. Aligns city with State of Colorado's safety plan
 - iv. Jim Arndt moved to authorize a letter that gets sent to City Council in advance of the May 19th meeting that expresses support of it. Jon Girand seconded the motion. Members generally supported the motion. We discussed a list of projects.
 - b. RTD: A memo will go to city council in support of sending a letter to RTD recommending extension of the 72 bus line to Candelas. RTD is planning to reinstate route 80, and 15-minute service will be restored to the G line on June 7.
5. **Dan Raine, Englewood Shuttle Service:**
 - a. Link on Demand was launched in August 2017
 - b. The service is free, operates Mon.-Sat.
 - c. Have utilized RTD partnership funding
 - d. Utilization requirement by RTD is 2 trips/hr/driver
 - e. Employer initiated
 - f. Started as first/last mile connector
 - g. Via operated, turnkey
 - h. Can do prescheduled trips
 - i. Have a call center but people mostly use an app
6. **Justin Begley - Denver Connector:**
 - a. Serves West Denver, Globeville, Elyria/Swansea
 - b. Equity focused-not a coverage service
 - c. 6 am to 8 pm
 - d. RTD Funded, Downtowner operated
 - e. Trips/hr range from 3-6
 - f. Most rides are called with the app
 - g. 24/7 staffed call center, can take calls in English and Spanish
 - h. No prescheduled trips
7. **Elijah Vignet-Kotze, Signal Timing:**

- a. **Completed:**
 - i. 64th Avenue: Quaker to Kipling, 25 intersection project, End to end travel reduction time up to 20%, DRCOG did modeling
 - ii. 86th Parkway-Indiana St to Independence Dr
 - iii. Indiana St. from 86th Parkway to 91st PI
 - b. **Ongoing:**
 - i. 80th Avenue: Alkire to Sheridan, preliminary results show a 10-20% improvement in the total network performance
 - ii. 72nd Avenue: Quaker to Lamar, planned for this fall
 - iii. Detour timings for construction projects and special events
 - c. **Upcoming:**
 - i. 58th/Ralston-Ward to Sheridan, plan to collaborate with DRCOG
 - ii. "Smaller" retiming projects 64th Ave East, 52 Ave, Olde Town
 - d. Would like to investigate smart signal technology, automated reporting, other advancements
